Notice of Race

1 Rules

The event will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009 - 2012*. Competitors should note that Chichester Yacht Club implements the RYA Racing Charter and expects competitors to sail in compliance with the charter.

2 Advertising

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority in accordance with ISAF regulation 20.

3 Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The event is open to Standard Lasers, Laser Radials and Laser 4.7s. Boats entered shall meet class rules, including the class sail measurement rules. In accordance with this, only official Laser sails may be used: **therefore please note: replica sails shall not be used.**

3.2 During the event the parent's or guardian's of young competitors shall either be in or around Chichester Yacht Club or afloat participating in the event, or will inform the event organisers in writing who is acting in loco parentis on their behalf. During the event any persons acting in loco parentis shall either be in or around Chichester Yacht Club or afloat participating in the event.

3.3 Eligible competitors may enter at the entry desk in the sloop at Chichester Yacht Club on any day of the event. A parent, guardian or person acting in loco parentis of all young competitors shall sign the entry form accepting the "Parent's or guardian's declaration regarding young competitors".

plus, Harbour dues, if not already paid:	£2

4 Racing Schedule:

The CYC South Coast Grand Prix Laser Open will be held on Saturday 21st April 2012.

Registration will take place at CYC in the Sloop from 08:30.

A briefing will be held at CYC in the Sloop at 09:30.

The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of the event will be 10:55

Subsequent races shall follow immediately after the preceding race.

There will be separate race series for Standard, Radial and 4.7 Lasers and it is planned that each race series will consist of three races.

High water details: 12:37 4.5m.

5 Sailing Instructions

Sailing Instructions will be available electronically on CYC's web sites, www.cyc.co.uk and www.cycdinghies.co.uk from 14th March 2012 at the latest and on paper during registration on the day.

6 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility. It is for the competitors to decide whether their boat and those that will sail it during the event are fit to sail in the conditions they might find. Each competitor is solely responsible for deciding whether or not to start or to continue racing and is also responsible for wearing adequate clothing for the conditions. By launching competitors confirm that their boat and those sailing it are competent to sail and compete in the event and are adequately clothed for the conditions.

The event organisers shall not be liable for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the competitors or accompanying persons as a result of attending or taking part in this event and those attending this event indemnifies the event organisers against all and any costs, claims, demands and liabilities in respect of the same.

The provision of patrol boats does not relieve persons in charge, competitors and those accompanying competitors of their responsibilities.

7 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 that is valid for this event and those sailing the boat.

8 Supporting Information

8.1 Young competitors are those under 18 years of age on the 21st April 2012.

8.2 Courses will be set and races will be held on the waters known as Chichester Lake.

8.3 To sail to the starting area once launched should take no more than 20 minutes.

8.4 Prizes will be awarded as detailed in the sailing instructions.

8.5 Results will be posted on CYC's web sites - www.cyc.co.uk and www.cycdinghies.co.uk

8.6 The Exoneration Penalty, Advisory Hearing and RYA Arbitration of the RYA Rules Disputes Procedures will be available during this event.

8.7 Support boats attending this event shall register at the entry desk during any registration period.

8.8 Competitors shall accept that photographs of their boat and its crew could be taken whilst attending this event.

8.9 In entering this event, competitors automatically grant the organising authority and Class Association the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show from time to time, at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and any other reproduction of them taken during the event, without compensation.

8.10 The event organisers encompass the organising authority, the race committee and the event support team. The race committee encompasses the principal race officer, the committee boat crew, the patrol boat personnel and the beach master, while the event support team encompasses all others that help run this event.

8.11 Competitors are asked not to leave road trailers in the car park, but to move them to the dinghy park or other area designated for the purpose.

8.12 The harbour dues paid at this event are for vessels less than 6.3m LOA taking part in open races organised by a local Chichester Harbour club for up to 2 days.
